SUFFIXES ARE ATTACHED TO THE END OF A ROOT TO PROVIDE FURTHER INFORMATION ABOUT A CONDITION. FOR EXAMPLE, THE SUFFIX "-ITIS" DENOTES INFLAMMATION, AS IN "ARTHRITIS" (INFLAMMATION OF THE JOINTS). FAMILIARITY WITH COMMON SUFFIXES AIDS CODERS IN UNDERSTANDING DIAGNOSES AND PROCEDURES ACCURATELY.
