- **LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION:** STRONG RECOMMENDATIONS FROM PROFESSIONAL CONTACTS CAN ENHANCE AN APPLICATION.
- **PERSONAL STATEMENT:** A WELL-CRAFTED PERSONAL STATEMENT OUTLINING CAREER GOALS AND MOTIVATIONS IS OFTEN NECESSARY.
