# **Understanding ASVAB and Its Purpose**

The Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery (ASVAB) is a multiple-aptitude test designed to assess a candidate's suitability for enlistment in the U.S. military. Percentile scores show the percentage of test takers in the reference group who scored at or below a candidate's score. For example, a percentile score of 70 means the individual scored better than 70 percent of all test takers. Percentile ranks are helpful for interpreting performance but are distinct from the AFQT score used for enlistment eligibility.

#### **How ASVAB Scores Are Calculated**

Calculating ASVAB scores involves several steps, starting with tallying raw scores and progressing through complex statistical adjustments. The scoring process ensures that results are reliable and equitable, regardless of the specific test version administered.

#### **Subtest Scoring Process**

Each ASVAB subtest score is derived from the number of correct answers. The test covers nine subtests, including Arithmetic Reasoning, Word Knowledge, Paragraph Comprehension, Mathematics Knowledge, Electronics Information, Auto and Shop Information, Mechanical Comprehension, General Science, and Assembling Objects. Raw scores from these subtests are converted into standard scores.

#### **Deriving the AFQT Score**

The AFQT score is computed using only four ASVAB subtests: Arithmetic Reasoning (AR), Mathematics Knowledge (MK), Word Knowledge (WK), and Paragraph Comprehension (PC). The formula involves combining WK and PC scores into a Verbal Expression (VE) score, then adding AR and MK scores to VE to calculate the AFQT raw score. This raw score is then converted into a percentile score to indicate eligibility for enlistment.

#### **Composite or Line Scores**

Composite scores, also known as line scores, are combinations of various subtest scores tailored to specific military job requirements. Each branch of the military may calculate composites differently, emphasizing particular aptitudes depending on the occupational specialty. These scores help determine qualification for specialized roles within the armed services.

# The Importance of the AFQT Score

The Armed Forces Qualification Test (AFQT) score is the most critical metric derived from the ASVAB. It serves as the primary measure of a candidate's eligibility to enlist in the military and is expressed as a percentile score ranging from 1 to 99.

#### **Minimum AFQT Score Requirements**

Each military branch sets its own minimum AFQT score requirements, which can vary based on recruitment needs and candidate background. Generally, a higher AFQT score increases the likelihood of acceptance and access to more desirable military occupational specialties.

### **Categories of AFQT Scores**

The Department of Defense classifies AFQT scores into categories that range from Category I (93-99 percentile) to Category V (1-9 percentile). Candidates in Categories I and II are considered the most qualified, while those in Category V are typically ineligible for enlistment.

Category II: 65-92 percentile

• Category IIIA: 50-64 percentile

• Category IIIB: 31-49 percentile

Category IVA: 21-30 percentile

Category IVB: 16-20 percentile

• Category IVC: 10-15 percentile

• Category V: 1-9 percentile (ineligible)

# Composite Scores and Military Occupational Specialties (MOS)
